You're holding in your hands the first wine list ever curated in its entirety by one of the world's most acclaimed wine critics, James Suckling, Chairman/Editor JamesSuckling.com.

He has rated close to 250,000 wines in his career and annually reviews more than 22,000 wines from key wine regions in France, Italy, Spain, Argentina, Chile, California, and Germany, even Thailand.

He rates the wines on a 100-point system: 95 points or more, fantastic quality; 90 points or more, outstanding quality, and 85 points or more, very good quality.

All wines featured on this list received a score of a minimum of 90 points and represent a very personal selection of wines that James enjoys drinking on his visits to The Nai Harn.

Instead of using traditional categories for wines in the list, James has organized them by style and usage, whether it's a fresh and crisp Thai Colombard for the pool or a structured red Bordeaux at dinner.

LARGE BOTTLE SIZES

"A MAGNUM BOTTLE OF WINE IS THE PERFECT SIZE FOR TWO PEOPLE IF ONE OF THEM ISN'T DRINKING." WHILE THAT MAY BE A BIT OF AN EXAGGERATION, IT'S TRUE THAT MAGNUM BOTTLES ARE EXCELLENT CHOICES FOR GROUP IMBIBING.

MAGNUM BOTTLES ALSO HAVE UNEXPECTED BENEFITS. ALTHOUGH THE BOTTLE ITSELF DOUBLES IN SIZE, THE CORK TYPICALLY DOES NOT. SINCE CORKS ARE NOT ENTIRELY AIRTIGHT, A SMALL AMOUNT OF OXYGEN SEEPS INTO ANY BOTTLE OVER TIME, AGING AND DEVELOPING THE JUICE ITSELF. THEREFORE, MAGNUM BOTTLES EXPOSE DOUBLE THE AMOUNT OF WINE TO ROUGHLY THE SAME AMOUNT OF OXYGEN, LENGTHENING THE AGING PROCESS AND KEEPING WINES FRESHER FOR LONGER.

Focused and complex on the nose with stone, sliced cooked apple and hints of toffee. Full-bodied, with a density and freshness and liveliness. Vivid and energetic.

Dönnhoff Riesling Nahe Felsenberg "Felsentürmchen" Schlossböckelheim GG, 2016, 97 points

Clearly the best dry wine I ever tasted from this great site! Perfectly ripe yellow peach nose with a delicate hint of smoke. Packed with ripe fruit, the muscularity of an Olympic sprinter, but this wine will go on and on long after those sprinters go into retirement. The dazzling acidity turns the finish into a fireworks display of minerals.

Superb aromas of black currants, rose petal and mint. Lavender and stones too. Full body with incredible fruit density. Complex, yet it's agile and bright. Tannins are perfectly polished. It builds on the palate and shows the structure of a first growth Bordeaux but remains so Chilean. A blend of 58% cabernet sauvignon, 15% carmenere, 12% malbec, 10% merlot, and 5% petit verdot. Klein Constantia, Vin de Constance 2015, South Africa, 96 points

Mesmerizing aromas of peaches, apricots, cream and vanilla with undertone of crushed stones. Medium to full body with a growing intensity on the palate. Chewy and phenolic tension, which is ever so finely grained. Fantastic length and focus. A super sweet wine. Clearly the best of South Africa. Tight and concentrated.

A round, layered Champagne with a full body and lots of flavor, yet it turns subtle and fresh at the end. Very citrusy and agrumi undertones. Grilled-bread and toasty character. 50% pinot noir and 50% chardonnay. Give this time to develop. 10,000 bottles made.
